and I next ac - know-ledge du - ly man-hood ta - ken by the Son.

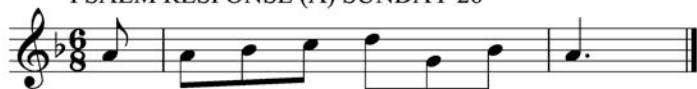
And I trust and hope most fully in that manhood crucified;

he guides the humble in the right path, he teaches his way to the poor.



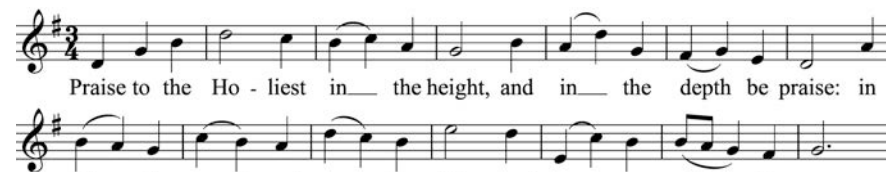

Franz Schubert (1797 – 1828) **Mass In C** Mozart **Epistle Sonata**

Written in June and July 1816, this delightful Mass was Schubert's fourth setting in two years. His model was Haydn and Mozart, and the Gloria and Credo have the usual extended symphonic treatment. But unique to Schubert, the master of the Lied, is the poetic character of the music, which impresses by its directness, harmonic lucidity and spiritual simplicity.

The **CBS Choir** presents a Solemn Mass at 11 am every Sunday, in the Christchurch Pro-Cathedral, exploring a wide repertoire of orchestral, contemporary, polyphonic and plainsong Masses.
